

NAMTA Policy and Procedures

Dues

NAMTA membership dues are \$20. NAMTA membership is open to any MTNA/OMTA member. You can join NAMTA when you join MTNA/OMTA online. Members that join after December 31 will only be required to pay half of their dues (\$10). Student MTNA members who join as professional members immediately after graduation pay only half their first year NAMTA dues.

Programs for meetings

Performances: **\$75 per performer** plus mileage @ .50/mile if traveling 20 miles round trip

Programs: **\$75 per program** outside of OMTA/NAMTA duties and curriculum requirements
(rate is the same for members and non-members. Handouts are included)

\$25 for college presentations to defray cost of handouts, etc.

Complimentary lunch for all presenters and performers (approx. \$15 per person)

Dues Incentive Program

All members with perfect annual business meeting attendance will be entered into a drawing to have your annual MTNA/OMTA/NAMTA dues reimbursed.

Conferences

NAMTA will pay for registration and assist with travel expenses for NAMTA's representative, an executive committee member, as determined by the President.

NAMTA Events

Composition Festival

Eligibility: Any NAMTA/OMTA/MTNA teacher can enter students.

Judging: The judge will receive **\$15 per work**

Entry Fees: \$15 per work. A student may enter more than one work per level but must pay an additional entry fee for each work.

Awards: Awards for Composition winners in each division will include a private lesson of 1-2 sessions with a professional composer who is a member of NAMTA. The fee is not to exceed \$30 per composer and may be scheduled for 1-2 hrs at the students request.

Fall Festival

Eligibility: Any OMTA teacher or NAMTA student member may enter students in the Fall Festival. There are no certification requirements for studios wanting to participate.

Judging: Judges are paid the OMTA rate of \$20 per hour plus current OMTA mileage (.50/mile) with a 1 hour minimum. Lunch is provided for any judges and monitors working a minimum of 3 hours.

Entry Fees: Solo Division **\$15**, 2-piece Division **\$20**, Ensemble Division **\$20**

Awards: The Senior Award is \$50 cash reward for each senior who has participated in solo memory division or ensemble division for 4 years.

Mall Marathon

Eligibility: Students of NAMTA teachers

Entry Fees: no entry fee

Scholarship Auditions

Eligibility: Students of a NAMTA teacher who are currently enrolled in grades 6-12. Students must have studied with their current teacher for at least 6 months. A student may not win more than 4 times. The instrument studied with the NAMTA teacher must be the primary camp focus.

Judging: \$75 (no mileage)

Entry Fees: **\$15** per student

Awards: There can be up to 4 winners with a \$800 cap on awards. Maximum award per student is \$200 and award checks will be made out to the student. If the student doesn't attend the camp, please return the award to NAMTA.
